Policy: DePiro Entertainment, LLC & Crazy Visions is committed to reducing the hazards associated with potential infectious viruses and infectious diseases such as the COVID-19 virus. We have developed the following new procedures for operating, to do all within our power to improve the health and safety of our team and event attendees. The safety and health of our attendees and team is our number 1 priority, so we expect these new procedures to be followed. In addition to these procedures, we understand that the world is ever evolving. If anyone has any other ideas or have a health or safety concern to address, please bring these thoughts up to the DePiro Entertainment or Crazy Visions Team so we can continue to improve this policy.

CDC Prevention Recommendations

According to resources available on the CDC website, there are many steps you can take to protect yourself, including:

Take steps to protect others

- **Stay home** if you are sick, except to get medical care. Learn what to do if you are sick.
- **WEAR A FACE MASK** If you plan on attending our events, you will be **required** to have a face mask or something that covers your face. We have the absolute right to refuse entry without refund if you attend our events without proper protection.

If you plan on attending our event, please follow these rules:

Clean your hands often

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds especially after you have been in a public place, or after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.
- If soap and water are not readily available, use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol. Cover all surfaces of your hands and rub them together until they feel dry.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.

[Throughout the day there are many times that you touch your face without thinking about it. Such activities include but are not limited to use of tobacco products, wiping your face, etc. Please do your best to avoid these activities and when necessary please sanitize your hands before performing these activities.]



Avoid close contact

- Avoid close contact with people who are sick
- Put distance between yourself and other people if COVID-19 is spreading in your community. This is especially important for people who are at higher risk of getting very sick.
- Continue to practice social distancing as much as possible while attending the event.

Cover coughs and sneezes

- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze or use the inside of your elbow.
- Throw used tissues in the trash.
- Immediately wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not readily available, clean your hands with a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.

Facemasks

*If sick **DO NOT come to our events** not because we would not love to have you, but because we care about our attendees and team. Everyone needs to remain safe and feel secure.*

- If you are sick: You should wear a facemask when you are around other people (e.g., sharing a room or vehicle) and before you enter a healthcare provider's office. If you are not able to wear a facemask (for example, because it causes trouble breathing) , then you should do your best to cover your coughs and sneezes, and people who are caring for you should wear a facemask if they enter your room. Learn what to do if you are sick.



Clean and Disinfect

- Clean AND disinfect frequently touched surfaces daily. This includes tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keyboards, toilets, faucets, and sinks.
- [DePiro Entertainment LLC will have a designated person(s) responsible for cleaning all frequently touched surfaces throughout the day at all events]

To disinfect: Most common EPA-registered household disinfectants will work. Use disinfectants appropriate for the surface.

Options include:

- Alcohol solutions. Ensure solution has at least 70% alcohol.
- Clorox Multi Surface Cleaner + Bleach
- Clorox Disinfecting Wipes
- Clorox Commercial Solutions Clorox Disinfecting Spray
- Lysol Heavy-Duty Cleaner Disinfectant Concentrate
- Lysol Disinfectant Max Cover Mist
- Lysol Clean and Fresh Multi-Surface Cleaner
- Purell Professional Surface Disinfectant Wipes
- Sani-Prime Germicidal Spray
- Diluting your household bleach. To make a bleach solution, mix: 5 tablespoons (1/3rd cup) bleach per gallon of water OR
- 4 teaspoons bleach per quart of water

Follow manufacturer's instructions for application and proper ventilation. Check to ensure the product is not past its expiration date. Never mix household bleach with ammonia or any other cleanser. Unexpired household bleach will be effective against coronaviruses when properly diluted.



Personal Hygiene

Since we are all in this together, I ask that we each help each other out and perform all recommended CDC practices at home. It is our job to keep each other safe and healthy. As a result we at DePiro Entertainment, LLC ask you to follow the best practices that are being recommended to stay safe and keep your family and our team safe from infection. Below are personal hygiene recommendations for both work and home.

- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your elbow when coughing or sneezing. It may prevent those around you from getting sick. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommends that everyone wear a facemask when in public.
- Avoid touching your face with unwashed hands. Germs are often spread when a person touches something that is contaminated with germs and then touches his or her eyes, nose, or mouth
- Clean your hands often with an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60-95% alcohol or wash their hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Soap and water should be used preferentially if hands are visibly dirty.
- Do not share tools if possible. Use proper cleaning methods between users if they are shared.
- Do not share personal protection equipment (PPE).
- Sanitize reusable PPE per manufacturer's recommendation prior to each use.
- Ensure used PPE is disposed of properly.
- Utilize disposable gloves where appropriate; wash hands after removing gloves.
- Disinfect reusable supplies and equipment
- Place all daily trash from vehicles and worksite in waste bins and dumpsters
- In the office we will have a person to clean all common areas and commonly used locations
- When using the bathroom wash hands before and after use
- When arriving home from work or any activity requiring you to leave from home, change clothes prior and wash clothes in hot water with laundry sanitizer.
- Avoid cleaning techniques, such as using pressurized air or water sprays that may result in the generation of bioaerosols.
